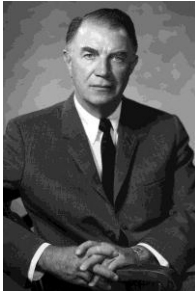




The Vickie Anne Palmer Foundation sponsors the Junior Achievement Titan Competition in honor of Drs. David & Agnes Palmer.



**David D. Palmer, D.C.**, was the grandson of D.D. Palmer, who in 1895 discovered chiropractic. In 1929, David Palmer earned a bachelor's degree from the Wharton School of Finance and Commerce of the University of Pennsylvania. Dr. David Palmer graduated from the Palmer School of Chiropractic in 1938 and served as president of Palmer College of Chiropractic from 1961-1978. During his tenure he strengthened and solidified the education status of the College, the world's first and foremost chiropractic educational institution. In addition, he founded Palmer Junior College which later merged with Scott Community College and was president of Palmer Broadcasting. With a strong passion for educating youth and philanthropy, Dr. David Palmer served on an extensive list of civic boards, including Junior Achievement.



**Agnes High Palmer, D.C.**, the wife of Dr. David D. Palmer, graduated from Palmer School of Chiropractic in 1938. Throughout her life she was prominent in the chiropractic profession, including serving as Supreme Kiatrus of the Alpha Grand Chapter of Sigma Phi Chi, the oldest chiropractic sorority. She also was an accomplished sculptress, receiving honors in the United States and Europe.

Drs. David & Agnes Palmer's legacy continues to live through today's youth.
