Bank Deposit Instructions



**Bank Deposit Deadline is
Thursday, March 1, 2012**



It is important to follow this banking process to ensure proper recognition for your team's fundraising efforts!

1. Team Captain(s) should collect bowler envelopes from each team member.
 - A. Collect all pledges (cash or check) from your teammates and determine your team's total.
 - B. Put your team's total pledges into the Team Captain Envelope. Be sure to complete the necessary information on the front of the Team Captain Envelope (name, organization, phone number, etc.)
 - C. Fill out deposit slip for your team's deposit.

2. If you have multiple teams for your organization please take your completed Team Captain Envelope to your Bowl-A-Thon Coordinator. This person will make the bank deposit for the entire organization. If you have one team from your organization the Team Captain is responsible for making the deposit.

3. Bowl-A-Thon Coordinators/Team Captains should drop off the Team Captain Envelope(s) at one of the following F&M Bank & Trust locations.

- A. The bank employees will process the deposit(s) at their convenience and return the deposit information and receipts to Junior Achievement for tracking purposes. You do not have to wait for the teller to process your deposit.
- B. You will not be provided with an original receipt from the bank. If you need a receipt, please note you will have to wait for the teller to count the deposit and provide a handwritten copy of the receipt. The original receipt will go to Junior Achievement.
- C. **The Bank Deposit Deadline is Thursday, March 1, 2012.**
- D. Junior Achievement can not accept money on the day of the JA Bowl-A-Thon event.



Junior Achievement Bowl-A-Thon Contest

- For every \$500 each team (5 bowlers) raises, one entry will be placed into a drawing—one lucky team will win a trip to Miami.*
- Each member of the winning team will receive lodging along with round-trip airfare from Chicago.**

*Official Contest Rules

1. You must be 18 years of age to be eligible to win travel prize. Bowlers under the age of 18 are only eligible to win \$200 cash prize.
2. A JA Bowl-A-Thon team is comprised of five individuals.
3. The team will receive one entry into the drawing for each \$500 in pledges raised.
4. Contest ends April 30, 2012. Winners will be announced by May 11, 2012.
5. Employees of Junior Achievement and the immediate family members of such employees are not eligible to win. The term "immediate family members" includes spouse, parents, grandparents, siblings, children and grandchildren.
6. Each member of the winning team receives a voucher for lodging and roundtrip airfare to Miami from Chicago. Maximum value of prize not to exceed \$700 per bowler. Prize must be redeemed by December 31, 2012.**
7. Winners will be notified by phone and are required to contact the Special Events Director at JA of the Heartland to redeem prize.
8. Redeemable until June 1, 2012 for \$200 cash per bowler in lieu of travel prize.

Firstgiving Online Fundraising

Junior Achievement is using Firstgiving Online Fundraising as a simple and fun way to raise funds for the bowl-a-thon. It is easy to use and a great way to connect with your family and friends.

How to use Firstgiving to help make fundraising a success:

Fundraising Suggestions



Junior Achievement has a variety of fundraisers designed to raise additional funds for your team's JA Bowl-A-Thon effort. In fact, teams of all sizes can coordinate such activities to promote their involvement. Here are some great ideas you might consider...



Online fundraising option available!

Bowlers can now create their own online fundraising page to secure donations. It's a fun and easy way to email your contacts and watch the donations roll in! More information is available inside this packet.

Items to sell:

- **Candygram Sale** – Employees can send Candygrams to each other with a small message. Five dollars is all you need to say "Thank you" or "Have a great day."
- **Jeans Days for JA** – Employees designate one day or even a week as Jeans Day for JA. Employees give a donation to be able to dress casually. Stickers available upon request.
- **JA Book Fair** – Host a book fair through Books Are Fun. This organization will help you with the set up and give 10% of the proceeds to your bowl-a-thon pledges. It's a great way for employees to purchase holiday gifts while helping you reach your fundraising goals.
- **50/50 Raffle** – Host a raffle once a week. Sell raffle tickets: 1 ticket for \$1, 6 tickets for \$5, or "Nose to Toes" for \$10. Split the cash earnings with the lucky ticket holder. Half will go to the winning ticket and the other half will go to JA.

Bosses Can Help Boost Your Bucks:

- **Get Bowled Over** – Decorate an employee's office space with bowling balls and pins. Leave a note stating the decorations can be removed for a donation to JA. Or, pay a special price and the decorations will be moved to an employee of their choice's workspace.
- **Go Home Early or Get a Day Off** – Have your boss collect money from employees that want to leave work early or take a day off.
- **Valet Parking** – Sell \$5 certificates that may be redeemed for valet parking. Employees will enjoy the benefit of having their car warmed up and ready to go on a cold winter's day.
- **Rock Star Parking Raffle** – Raffle off your best parking spot to employees.
- **Pie in the Face Contest** – Select a list of candidates and sell \$1 votes to see who will receive the pie in their face. Employees can vote as many times as they want and all votes are kept anonymous.

Contests:

- **Trivia Nights** – Charge an entry fee for individual and/or teams to take part. The winning team gets a prize. You will need a venue for this fundraiser!
- **Eating Contest** – Hold an eating contest with pies, buffalo wings, ice cream, or anything else you can scarf down! For an entry fee people can compete in this showdown. You can also charge a nominal fee for those that just want to watch.
- **Wii Tournament** – Pick your favorite Wii game and host a tournament. Teams can enter for a small fee and compete against each other over a lunch hour or staff fun day.

Food Events:

- **Soup Day** – In your employee break room, supply several crock pots of soup, lots of bread, desserts, and drinks. Charge a fee for all those that want to participate.
- **S'mores** – Warm up your toaster oven and have lots of graham crackers, marshmallows, and chocolate bars. Sell these toasty treats for a dollar a piece. Don't forget the small paper plates, napkins, pan, and oven mitt for this easy fundraiser.
- **Potluck Lunch** – Everybody brings a dish to share and contributes \$5 to eat lunch.
- **Valentine's Day Cookie Sales** – Decorate heart-shaped cookies and sell to employees for their favorite Valentine.
- **Bake Sale** – Have everyone bring in their favorite home baked treats and sell them during employees' lunch break.
